You want to love, but when love begins to flow you get fearful and love stops. Fear of rejection is the trigger that makes you pullback. Actually, if you knew that fear kills love you would stop it right there and then. There is no need to be afraid of love. Work on your fears and improve your love, your source of light and life.

My teaching is about love, life and light. Where there is fear there is negative energy. Love is a positive energy. Finish all negativities. Any negative force pulls you down. Fear is always negative. When you fear you will not be able to feel love towards anyone. Fear deprives you the experience of true enjoyment and it negates the aliveness of love. Actually fear kills liveliness and love. Don't be afraid of Love; be afraid of fear.

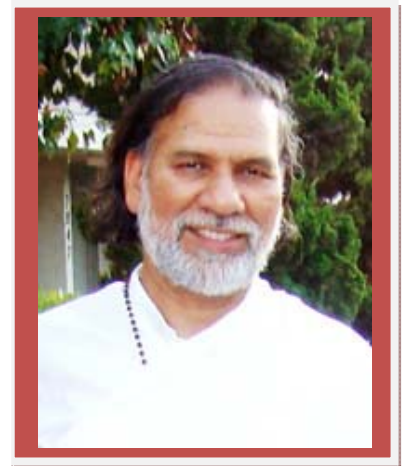
If you are so afraid of loving someone, just wait and let it grow slowly. In love something has to click. Just let it happen. But if you are so afraid of rejection you will never be able to love anyone. There is a 50/50 chance of rejection, but if you stop your love because of your fear it will be like committing slow suicide. My advice to you is to always be full of love. If you are always full of love, prayer will happen.

In fact the highest peak of love is the lowest point of prayer. But you have to be full of love, full of life and full of energy otherwise fear will easily attach on you.

Take a step. Finish all of your fears. In a deep state of love you can reach your highest state of consciousness. When two people are really in love they feel very relaxed. They feel no tension, no rejections and no resistance. Their love has become prayer.

Live your life in deep love and away from fear. Don't feed your fear by paying attention to it. Turn your back to fear and move towards love's vitality. Allow it to increase, and never be afraid. You are full of love energy inside; simply let it happen. Once it happens others will begin to see something unique and will be attracted to you.
